- 1. What was context and content of the Methuen Treaty, between Portugal and England. (5 points)
 - Explain immediate historical precedents and context
 - Describe content of Treaty
 - Briefly mention impact of Treaty
- 2. Distinguish and explain the concepts of "absolute advantage" and "comparative advantage" in International Economics. (5 points)
 - Place these concepts in their due context choices of specialization of States in production of certain goods
 - Define concept of absolute advantage and identify its origin (Adam Smith)
 - Define concept of comparative advantage and identify its origin (David Ricardo)
- 3. Explain what is the practice of "dumping", as the concept is used in international economic law and (wrongly) in competition law and in unfair commercial practices law. (5 points)
 - Explain the concept in each of these 3 areas of the law and distinguish the practices at the heart of each

- 4. Explain why tariffs are often described as "hidden taxes" and why there is a "democratic bias" in favour of the adoption or increase of tariffs, instead of imposing new taxes or raising them. (5 points)
 - Tariffs being paid ultimately by consumers
 - Consumers / citizens not usually being aware of how tariffs work and their impact, not immediately feeling impact on their wallets
