

## CHECKLIST FOR OUTGOING STUDENTS

### **Before leaving:**

- I checked with the host Higher Education Institution, the documents I should present on arrival (ex.: photographs, rules on residence permit, student visas, etc.).
- I got informed about the deadlines for submission of documents and communicated them to GERI.
- I got on procedures upon arrival (ex.: welcome session, description, etc.).
- I got informed on which documents GERI should send to validate nomination.
- I handed the study plan (Learning Agreement) in, signed by me, to the GERI
- I handed in all the documents requested by the host Higher Education Institution to the GERI, to be validated.
- GERI issued the registration statement and the transcript of records and sent them to the host higher education institution.
- Have I got the declaration of the exchange student status in GERI?
- I registered at FDUL and have all tuitions paid.
- I have in my possession the acceptance letter from the host HEI.
- I've made accommodation arrangements for my arrival and stay.
- I have my visa (applicable only for EU countries)
- I have the plane ticket.
- I've done my International Student Card.
- I have a valid Identity Card / Passport.
- I have the European Health Insurance Card. (applicable only for EU countries).
- I have pocket money for the first few days.

### **During the stay:**

- I sent GERI, by email, the declaration of arrival already signed by the host higher education institution (within 15 days after my arrival).
- I requested changes to my learning agreement, following the procedures set by FDUL to recognize the courses I take abroad.
- GERI approved the amendments to the original study plan.
- I filled out and sent the request for extension to GERI, already signed by the host HEI.

### **Upon return:**

- I handed in the Declaration of stay and the declaration of arrival dully signed and filled out to the GERI
- I submitted the Student Report in the European platform (Mobility Tool), within 15 days after receiving the report.
- GERI received the transcript of records from the host HEI.
